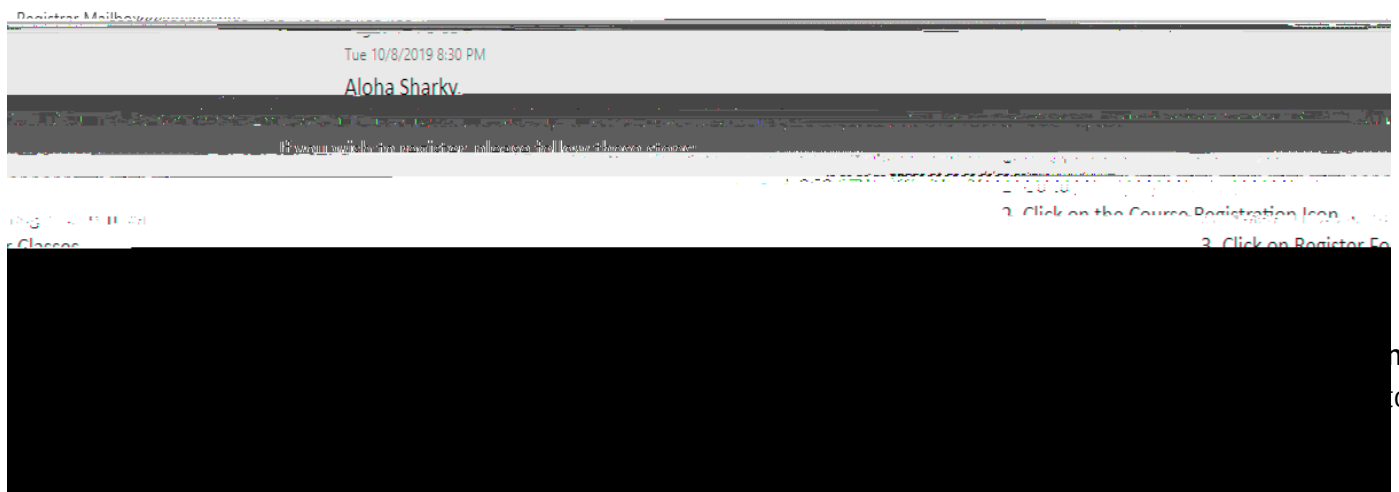


Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is a registration waitlist?

The registration waitlist is an electronic list of students wanting to register for a class that is closed (i.e. has no available seats). Students may sign up for this electronic waitlist when they attempt to register for a class section that has reached its maximum enrollment. If a seat in the class becomes available, the first student on the registration waitlist for the class will be notified via email (notifications will only be sent to student's @my.hpu.edu email account). Once notified, the deadline for students to register is listed below for reference.

4. How will students know when a seat becomes available in the class they are waitlisted for?

If a seat in the class becomes available, the student will be notified via email (notifications will only be sent to student's @my.hpu.edu email account). Once notified, the deadline for students to register for class will be 24 hours from date/time stamp of email notification.
