depending on our university budget at the time of their acceptance. After the students have been accepted, one of our staff will have a short 5-10-minutes casual interview during the orientation to make sure their conversational English is high enough to participate.

Students will receive the results whether they are granted the scholarship at the time of their acceptance (usually one month after application due date) by email.

The Cultural Internship duties include 1:1 English language exchange with Korean students up to 15 hours a week, some cultural events, and having a Korean roommate.
